# Jankara

## Vermentino di Gallura 2011

This single-vineyard wine from northern Sardinia is only the second vintage from a highland estate planted by Renato and Angela Spanu in 2008. It is a full-bodied, broad, fairly powerful white with oily texture typical of Vermentino. Its aromas and flavors suggest ripe peaches and peach stone,

with a slight floral note, and its long, rich, honeyed finish attests to the quality of the wine. The weight and richness of this wine is due to the vintage, making the wine, according to Renato Spanu, the polar opposite of the 2010 Jankara. This is an unusual and compelling wine worth knowing. It is drinking well now, delicious alone or with light meats or rich fish dishes.

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
